Purpose of the course	<p>This course allows students to pursue independent research, and the development of a personalised learner response to their chosen project objectives, the Extended Project is a way of achieving deeper, more reflective understanding of a subject area or to look at a new one they have a personal interest in.</p> <p>Essentially, this is a matter of challenging learners to think more reflectively and analytically about the main concepts that they use in their project and which they might ordinarily take for granted.</p>

Course contents	<p>Level 3 Extended Projects aim to support learners with the transition to Higher Education or into the world of work. They provide opportunities for the development of critical, reflective, problem-solving and independent learning skills through the planning, research and evaluation of a self-selected project.</p> <p>Throughout their in-depth study, learners will develop and apply skills creatively, resulting in one of the four following project outcomes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● A dissertation● An Investigation● A Performance; or● An artefact		
Assessment method	<p>Students produce:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● a project proposal● diary of their work● a project outcome (eg dissertation)● a presentation <p>These are internally assessed There is no external examination</p>
